Dear Mr. Diaz:

Clear Channel Communications Inc. and its wholly owned subsidiary Citicasters Co. (collectively "Clear Channel") agree that under currently established governmental and technical standards applicable to FM radio broadcasts, the broadcasts of the FM radio station known as XHLNC-FM 90.7 MHz, licensed to Tijuana, Baja California Mexico ("XHLNC") does not interfere in any manner with the broadcast of the FM radio station KGB-FM 101.5 MHz, licensed to San Diego California or the broadcast of any other Fm owned or operated by Clear Channel (collectively the "clear Channel Stations").

Clear Channel hereby withdraws any objections Clear Channel may have communicated prior to the date of this letter to any governmental or regularity authority to the effect that the FM radiobroadcast of XHLNC interferes in any manner with the FM radio broadcast of any of the Clear Channel Stations. Clear Channel is providing this letter based on your representations that you will not increase (nor attempt to increase) the authorized or actual power of XHLNC's transmissions above their current level.

In the event the governmental and/or technical standards applicable to FM radio broadcasts change in the future or there is any change to the current operating parameters of the station, Clear Channel reserves the right to object at that time to any actual or potential interference that may occur between the FM radio broadcast of XHLNC and the Fm radio broadcast of any of the Clear Channel Stations.

Clear Channel authorizes you to provide a copy of this letter to any governmental or regulatory authority for the purpose of establishing that Clear Channel does not currently have any objections, and has withdrawn all prior objections, with respect to the FM radio broadcast of XHLNC.
