Dear Mr. Castaneda:

I am writing in reference to the unauthorized operation of XHTNA, channel 214A, in Tijuana, BN. Our letter of November 6, 2000 requested a resolution to the problem of interference caused by this Tijuana station. To date we have yet to receive a response to this request. We have attached a history of the correspondences between our respective Administrations. Based on recent contact from our US licensees, the XHTNA station continues to cause severe destructive interference to KPFK in Los Angeles, CA in addition to the violation of the IF separation spacing to channel 268C in San Diego. This unauthorized operation of XHTNA, is in direct violation of the terms of the USA-Mexico FM Broadcast Agreement as in addition to the interference it causes, its operation was never officially notified by your Administration for the Commission's evaluation.

The Commission requests that the operation of XHTNA immediately cease operation at this unauthorized site until an appropriate resolution to the destructive interference it is causing can be developed.

Please contact us as soon as possible so that this matter can be resolved with all due haste. Thank you for your assistance.
