Dear Madam Secretary:

Pursuant to Section 325(c) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, the University of Southern California, licensee of KUSC(FM), Los Angeles, KCPB(FM), Thousand Oaks, KPSC(FM), Palm Springs, and KFAC(FM), Santa Barbara, all California (collectively, "KUSC" or the "Applicant") hereby requests authority to deliver program material to a foreign broadcast station whose signal is consistently received in the United States. This letter request is being filed pursuant to FCC Form 308, Instructions, paragraph C ("If the applicant holds a valid radio . . . broadcast station license . . . an informal application (in letter form) may be used in lieu of this form.").

KUSC and XLNC1, a California non-profit corporation, have entered into a "Programming and Fundraising Services Agreement," dated as of August 17, 2002 (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which KUSC proposes to make available certain program material to radio station XHLNC, 90.7 MHz, Tijuana, B.C., Mexico, for broadcast in Tijuana and San Diego, California. Under the Agreement, KUSC will deliver classical music programming and related promotional and fundraising announcements in the English language (the "programming") for

the radio service of the University of Southern California

KUSC-FM 91.5 Los Angeles KCPB-FM 91.1 Thousand Oaks KFAC-FM 88.7 Santa Barbara KPSC-FM 88.5 Palm Springs

broadcast by XHLNC daily between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto.

XHLNC is authorized to operate from Tijuana at 1,000 watts ERP pursuant to a concession issued to Sr. Victor Manuel Diaz Romo, the principal of XLNC1, by the Secretaria de Comunicaciones y Transportes of Mexico in accordance with applicable treaties between the Governments of the United States of America and the United Mexican States. Under the Agreement, KUSC will deliver the programming *via* satellite to XHLNC at its facilities located at Avenida Club 20-30 3724, Colonia Juarez, Tijuana, B.C. 22150, Mexico.

KUSC will comply with the local public notice provisions of Section 73.3580(c)(2) of the Commission's Rules.
