BRCC Annual Meeting 1/5/2019 Berkeley Yacht Club

Meeting called to order at 11:01am

Grant - President

Grant pointed members to the BRCC website (<u>https://people.well.com/user/pk/</u> <u>berkeleydragons/</u>) for information on BRCC. The "Documents and Forms" section has bylaws, operating rules and waivers, steering test, steering instructions, minutes, etc.

He stressed the need for volunteers to step up in advance of outreach events.

Gary Tang - Treasurer

Gary outlined the changes made in 2018, including

- 2 signatures needed for checks over \$1000
- Bookkeeping changed to Quickbooks
- Closed one savings account
- Dividends are automatically reinvested
- Purchased VTI shares from idle cash
- Sold 50 shares AAPL
- Invested \$6000 at 2.45% 12-mo. CD
- Set aside some reserves

He noted that all dues go to the checking account for operations. Investments are all from donations.

Gary's financial statements are included at the end of the minutes.

Grant says we just got a \$2300. bill for painting the Max boat. Ruby is being painted now and it is expected that it will also be \$2300. We put aside \$12000 for a new dock a couple of years ago pending permission from marina people. We also need to set aside money for liability insurance and hull insurance.

Warren' requested a vote on whether we should stop using Wells Fargo for banking. Grant said we should bring it up at the next board meeting. Warren moved that we get a general feeling from the group about moving from Wells Fargo. Jill seconded the motion. 28 were in favor of moving funds. 23 did not vote in favor of moving funds.

Judy Lee reminded members about two easy ways to raise funds.

- Employee matching contributions might be available so ask for corporate matches.
- Remember to purchase Amazon items through Amazon Smiles.

Sandy - Outreach

In 2018 we hosted 21 outreach events for organizations ranging from schools, camps and choirs to the Air Force Band. More than 2000 guest paddlers participated.

Members are encouraged to actively promote auction events. Other events happen through verbal outreach. If you do promote an event, you will be expected to help with it. You will be in charge of communication and finding paddlers and steerspeople. If there is more than 1 boat involved, bring it to the board first for approval. There is a Google form for interested parties to fill out to help keep everything organized.

Sandy is using BRCC email, not DragonMax mail to keep everything on one calendar.

Thanks to Patrice, Christina and Mary for all the help with Bayfest and July 4. Infant and XL pfds as well as children's paddles were purchased to use at these events.

Upcoming events for which many volunteers will be needed:

- April 6 Bay Festival
- July 4

There's just one other event pending - no date is set yet.

Volunteers are needed! If you work during the week, volunteer on a weekend!

Gina - Membership

There were 158 active members in 2018. 25 were new members. BRCC is now collecting dues for ongoing membership at the beginning of the year. New members joining January-June, \$100. July 1-Dec: \$50. Dues can be paid to Gina by check or Gary or Linda by PayPal.

The 2019 waiver is not available yet.

It was asked whether membership dues can be considered donations. Would they be eligible for a corporate match? Can sports memberships be considered donations?

PIZZA!

Mike - Fleet Captain

One of the fleet captain's main responsibilities is organizing boat cleaning. Mike wants to have a rotating boat cleaning event once a month, 2 weeks after birthday celebrations. We have started using a power washer on the boats and it works really well. Respond to Mike so he knows how many people to expect for boat cleaning events.

Other improvements include:

- The Champion and small boat seats have 3 new coats of oil-based varathane.
- Max and Ruby are being painted so paddling them will be much easier.
- Mike made a new box for paddles.
- The white brushes boat cleaning brushes are modified and are now easier to use if you sit on dock

• The Harbormaster says they will fix the big cracks in the dock.

Gary Young - Small Fleet

What is the small fleet?

- 5 sit -inside kayaks used for time trials. Store them upside-down to keep water out.
- 3 OC1s used for DragonMax time trials, US national team time trials, touring and racing.
 C1 Red/orange Kaku
 - C2 white and red hurricane it's fast.
 - C3 white with green ama suitable for larger people
- 1 OC 2 white/blue
- Canoes 1 green, 1 white used for maintenance and crew support
- See Gary or Katherine or Jane with questions or for instruction

If you see anything wrong with the fleet, let Gary know immediately.

Training

OC and kayak certification are needed for individual use. Gary has the list of people already certified. You must be able to flip the boat and bring it back upright. He will give OC1 training but not until the spring. Until then, he will take you out in OC2 any Saturday after practice - email him to set it up. Wetsuits are encouraged.

Gary is very hesitant to allow small boats outside breakwater. He will send out a copy of the safety rules.

Sign-in sheets are in the paddle locker along with seats and iakus.

Gary modified a couple of old paddles for technique practice in a stationary boat.

Regine - Competition Director

It was a busy summer with lots of teams using the boats

Upcoming races include Lake Merced, CDBA races, Long Beach, and the qualifying races for Club Crew World Championships in Vancouver, WA and Colorado Springs.

The Rough Riders high school team is still around and Lawrence is recruiting and coaching them.

Corporate teams are always welcome.

Annette Adams - ATT

ATT is the most active corporate team and they will have a team again this year. They participate in two novice races each year in Foster City and at Lake Merritt. There is an open house in April to give people a chance to paddle, and there are three scheduled practices each year before racing. ATT appreciates BRCC support.

Berman - International Races - Team DNA.

Team DNA provides lots of opportunity to paddle. There is an annual race in the Philippines in Boracai. Paddlers from over seven countries now race in Hong China, Malaysia, China, etc. Team DNA is open to everyone interested. The goal is to meet paddlers from different countries and have a good time. Berman is checking on whether the Boracai race will happen this spring.

Judy - cancer survivors - Live Love Survive

Live Love Survive's founder moved to Morro Bay so it has now become a part of BRCC. Live Love Survive needs to use BRCC's equipment and would like to arrange for specific donations to be earmarked for cancer survivors. Judy and Alice are exploring the possibility of a breast cancer survivor team.

Election of Officers

All officers have said they are willing to serve again but everyone is encouraged to step up to be nominated.

Ray renominates everyone for the board. All were in favor so the 2018 board members will serve for another year.

Sandy suggests a communications position on the board. Facebook? Google group? The suggestion will be discussed at the next board meeting.
