Approval of minutes

Sandy moved to approve the minutes. Grant seconded. All voted in favor.

President's Report - Grant

Grant has nothing new to add. He thanks to Astrid for her work on the website.

Vice President's Report - Paul

Paul has approved 4 new steerspeople - 3 from Cal plus Jeannie.

Paul sent an article about Bay Fest to BerkeleySide.

The Berkeley Police Dept. will be moving their traffic bureau to L Dock, so hopefully that will alleviate the car break-in situation. There will also be a police substation. Permits will be strictly enforced early in the morning and they will be charging \$10 for the ferry parking lot. At some point the city may be closing M Dock parking but parking should be available at Skate's.

Treasurer's Report - Gary T (see report at end of minutes)

We spent more money on maintenance this year than in most years. We have \$6,000 left for the year and \$2000 is allocated to races.

The investments are doing well. Apple is up to ~\$200 per share. We can take on some kind of project if we use investments.

Outreach - Sandy

There are a few things trickling in for the summer. YMCA and Armada are on the books. Astrid will be adding the calendar to the website. Contact her with any feedback on the site. Question: Does each child need to have 1 adult? Does it need to be a guardian? What about a parent with 3 kids?

Membership - Gina

Gina was asked about a summer-only reduced-fee membership and it was decided that there should be no summer-only memberships. They have to be the first or second half of the year. We will give Pat Robak a choice of either refunding the whole year's membership or deferring membership to another year.

In order to clarify policy regarding membership fee refunds, it was decided that the word "nonrefundable" should be added to the "dues" section of the membership application.

Small fleet - Gary Y

Kayaks were deployed and some needed maintenance. Katherine will give Gary a list. OC1s are all operational. OC2 takes on water and Gary will investigate.

Fleet - Mike (in absentia)

Will take bolts off of old storage shed so the new one will fit next to it.

New business

Warren presented a new dock and hoist system. He likes False Creek's dock system (ramp with lower end almost touching water that boats get dragged up on or pushed down into the water.) Warren says it looks like it's low-maintenance, safe, and easy. Warren's drawings show where boats would be stored if hoisted. Total cost \$17,000 for dry docking

Paul presented a plan that would hoist boats vertically out of the water. Paul's plan takes into account permitting from city and BCDC. It's a minimal plan to stay under the radar. He estimates CanDock docking system with a 20 year warranty. ~\$40/sf
